

## **Terms and Conditions for PMAV Australian Gold Prospecting Expo – 15th & 16th April 2023 Raffle**

- The raffle is open to all Australian residents 18 years old or over.
  - The raffle is organised and run by the Prospectors and Miners Association of Victoria
  - Online Tickets can be purchased by depositing money into PMAV account with email as reference.
- Online sales close 12pm (midday) Saturday 15th 2023. ALL ticket sales close 2.45pm Sunday 16th 2023.
- The PMAV will send online ticket number(s) purchased via email address provided by the buyer
  - The PMAV and nominee accepts no responsibility for any entries that are incomplete, unpaid for. It is not the responsibility of the PMAV to ensure email and contact details are correct and copy of ticket(s) allocated. Money refunded upon PMAV mistake.
  - **Tickets are \$5 each.** Buy \$10 lots and get 3 tickets. Example: \$10 tickets purchased-3 tickets allocated, \$40 tickets-12 tickets allocated, \$50 tickets-15 allocated etc
  - A maximum of 1500 tickets only will be allocated.
  - The draw will be conducted by an impartial/independent member of the public at 2.45pm 16<sup>th</sup> April at Bendigo Australian Gold Prospecting Expo.
  - The first drawn ticket will receive the highest value prize, the NOX800 Minelab, followed by each ticket winning the second highest valued prize and next drawn third highest value and so on until all prizes are drawn.
  - A winning ticket is not returned to the barrel, however multiple ticket holders can win more than one prize.
