Track upgrades have commenced

Parks Victoria contractors have commenced work to upgrade and re-open five access tracks into popular visitor sites along Reedy Creek.

Contractors are currently in the area completing treatment of hazardous trees.

The contractors have been inducted by Parks Victoria and will commence works this week. The works will include forming of new drainage lines, sheeting and grading of the track surface.

How will these works impact my access to Reedy Creek?

Weather permitting, the completion of these works is expected by the end of March 2025.

There will be machinery operating at these sites. People who are camping or prospecting in the immediate vicinity of construction works may be asked to temporarily move location to another site on Reedy Creek. You can return once the work is finished.

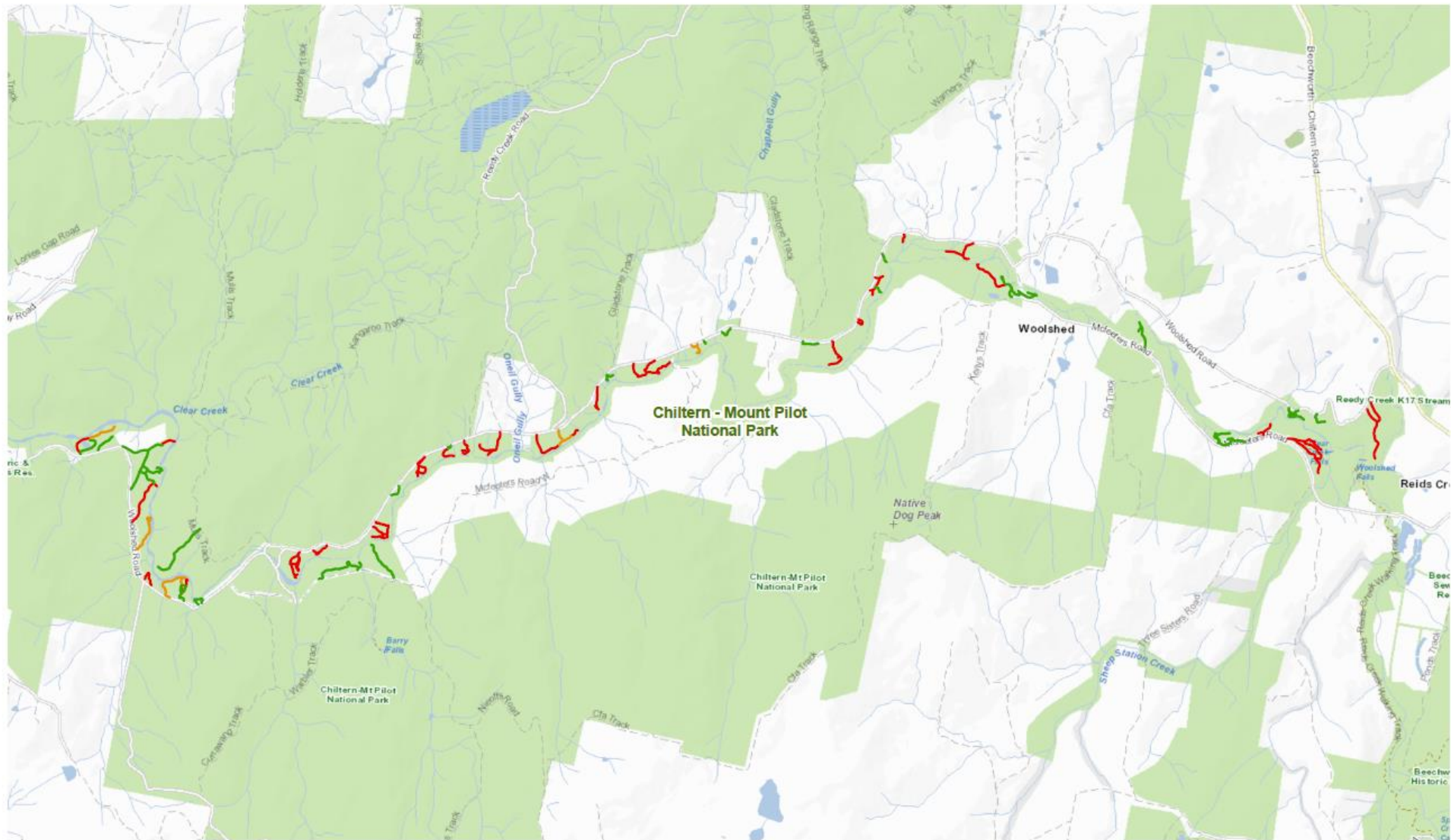
Visitors will notice that while 5 tracks will be upgraded, several tracks will remain closed and will be rehabilitated. These tracks have signage in place asking visitors not to use these tracks but to use the new upgraded tracks to access Reedy Creek.
